INTRODUCED BY SEN. MANNY VILLAR

**AN ACT
ESTABLISHING NATIONAL CEMETERIES AND PROVIDING FOR THEIR
ADMINISTRATION AND MAINTENANCE**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the
Philippines in Congress assembled:*

SECTION 1. There shall be established at least one (1) National Cemetery in each Region and major island to serve as a memorial and final resting place for veterans, military personnel and citizens who have rendered distinguished services to the nation.

SECTION 2. The President of the Philippines shall establish each National Cemetery by individual Presidential Proclamation which shall set aside a portion of government land for the purpose.

SECTION 3. Military veterans and military personnel who die in the line of duty, persons who have rendered distinguished service to the nation, and such other persons as may be determined by the President of the Philippines shall be entitled to burial in the national cemetery.

SECTION 4. The administration, maintenance, and security of the national cemeteries shall be under the jurisdiction of the Philippine Veterans Affairs Office (PVAO). Funds for the purpose shall be included in the annual appropriations of the PVAO.

SECTION 5. All laws, orders, or decrees in contravention herewith are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
